### **Code of Conduct:**

Discipline and self-control are critical elements in the performing arts. At Vostrikov's Academy of Ballet, we strive to provide a creative and respectful learning environment for all students. It is the expectation that students will show proper respect for their instructors as well as for their fellow-students at all times.

Directors and instructors expect all students to act in an appropriate manner in keeping with the art form of dance by arriving on time for class, attending class regularly, listening and responding to instruction, abstaining from inappropriate language, and maintaining a cooperative, respectful, non-disruptive demeanor before, during, and after class. Any disruptive behavior will be acknowledged and students will be expected to correct their behavior immediately as not to detract from overall instruction time, which impacts fellow-students and instructors negatively.

Instructors reserve the right to ask any student(s) who do(es) not properly respond or show continual disruption to leave class for that day. Repeated and/or unimproved behavior will be addressed directly with the parents and could lead to permanent removal from the class and/or the academy.
